1. How can I become a volunteer for the after-school program?

2. Do volunteers need any special qualifications?

3. What types of tasks will volunteers be involved with?

4. Are volunteers required to undergo a background check?

Yes, all volunteers are required to undergo a background check to ensure the safety and well-being of the children in our program.

5. Can volunteers choose their schedule?

Volunteers are welcome to choose their schedule based on availability, but we do ask that volunteers commit to a regular time to ensure consistent support for the children.

6. Will volunteers receive any benefits or recognition?

Volunteers will gain valuable experience in child care, have the opportunity to build skills, and will be recognized for their contributions. We also offer certificates or letters of recommendation for volunteers who complete a significant amount of service.
